Got Drugs?

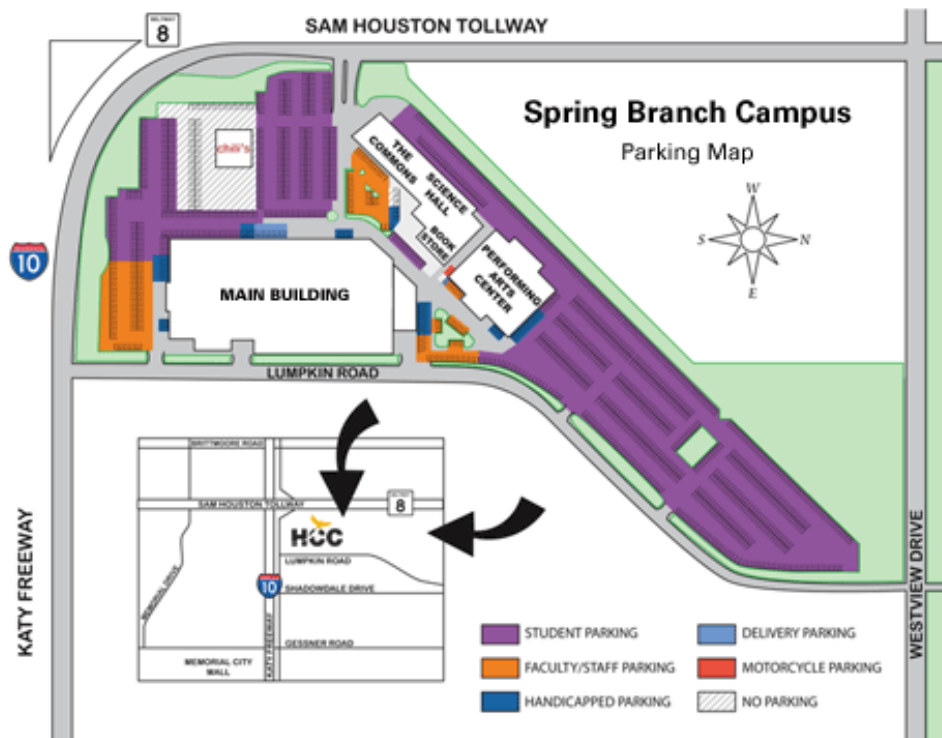
